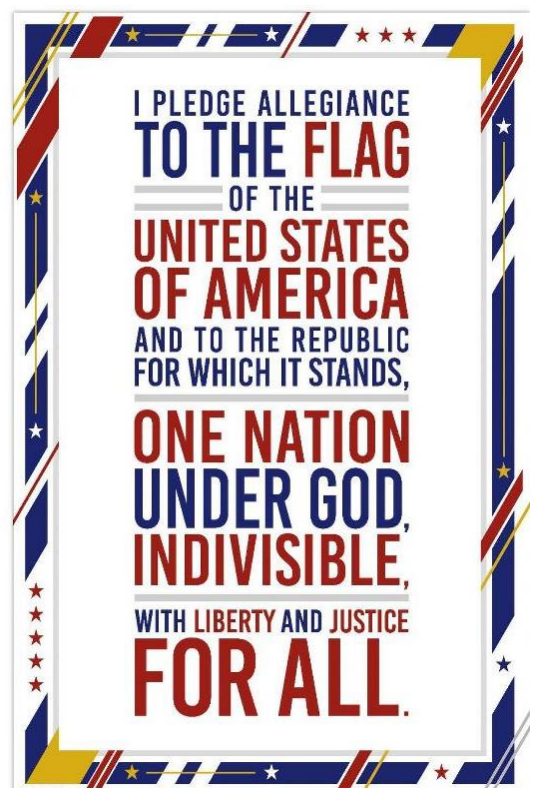
We offer prayers of thanksgiving for those who visited this past month.

When hanging the Flag against a wall, vertically or horizontally, the Flag's union (stars) should be at the top, to the Flag's own right and the observer's left.
